Principles

Our policy is that all children at Whitchurch CofE Primary school should wear clothing which identifies our pupils as part of our school family, promoting a strong cohesive school identity. Smart and high standards of appearance are expected.

We believe the school uniform is important as it:

- Looks smart
- Contributes to a sense of belonging
- Is practical and distinctive
- Identifies the children with the school
- Children feel equal to one another in terms of appearance

School Uniform Requirements

All school uniform and PE kits should be clearly labelled with the child's name.

Whitchurch C of E Primary School uniform:

- Maroon sweatshirts or cardigans with the school logo (available from Skoolkit) or maroon without the logo from any retailer
- School logo zip up fleece instead of sweatshirts/cardigans in maroon (from Skoolkit)
- Grey or black Trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafores
- White polo shirts or cotton shirts
- Black/grey/white socks/ tights
- Black school shoes or sensible black boots which are flat
No trainers, platforms, sling backs, crocs or Ugg style boots. In the summer months dark coloured sandals are permitted although children will need to change into plimsolls/trainers to use the climb-arounds during playtime.
- In Summer months dresses/playsuits in red/white check are permitted

Your child will also require:

- Coat/waterproof
- Woolly hat/gloves/scarf or sun hat
- Apron or large shirt for years 1 -6 – to protect clothing during art lessons
- Wellingtons for pupils in Years R

PE Kit

- White, round necked T-shirt with or without the school logo (logo item from Skoolkit)
- Maroon P.E. shorts
- Black plimsolls or plain coloured trainers for P.E. in Years R - 2
- Plain coloured trainers for PE/Games in Years 3 – 6
- Plain dark coloured track suit for outdoor games in winter months in Years 3 – 6

Bookbags and Rucksacks

- Bookbags, for Year R -2 are essential, there isn't enough room in the cloakroom to accommodate rucksacks. You can purchase any maroon bookbag, but school logo ones can be purchased from the school office.
- Rucksacks are permitted for years 3 – 6 and we accept any rucksacks providing they fit in the lockers or on pegs.
- PE Kit bag (any colour).

Second Hand Uniform

The Friends of Whitchurch Primary School (FOWPS) run a second hand uniform sale every month at the school.

Appearance

Jewellery

Children may wear single gold or silver stud earrings. An inexpensive plain wristwatch may be worn. Smart watches are not permitted. No other jewellery will be permitted for health and safety reasons. In accordance with Hampshire guidelines children are required to remove earrings for PE unless they have just had their ears pierced and then they may cover them for the first six weeks.

Hair

Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied back with small, discreet hairbands, large bows or hair accessories are not permitted.

Extreme haircuts, e.g., tramlines, shaved shapes are not permitted. Dyed hair is not permitted.

Mobile Phones

We are a smartphone free school, in line with many other schools. Children in Years 5 and 6 may bring a 'brick' phone to school to be turned off and stored in the office during the school day. Younger children are not to bring phones to school.

Items with school logo

Items of clothing with the Whitchurch CE Primary School logo can be purchased via Skoolkit, although suitable alternatives without the school logo can be purchased from many suppliers. Book bags with the school logo can be purchased from the school office.
