Dear Parents and Carers

We have a couple of exciting upcoming events in Year 5. As you know, at the end of this half term, we have our Café event and next half term we have a theatre trip booked to see 'Matilda, the Musical' at the Mayflower Theatre in Southampton. Please see further details about these events below.

Event 1 – Café.

The children are looking forward to inviting you into school for our Café event this term. These will happen on two separate days:

Kingfishers: Tuesday 17th March

Doves: Wednesday 18th March

In order for us to prepare for this, we need to know how many to cater for. Both café events will start at **2:15pm** and will need to finish at 3:00pm. The event will be held in the large hall therefore we are restricting numbers to **2 attendees per family**.

To help to cover costs associated with the purchase of ingredients for our café event and our practise sessions we are asking for voluntary donations of £5 per child which can be paid via SCOPay by .

Event 2 – Southampton Theatre trip.

Year 5 will be going on a trip to the Mayflower Theatre in Southampton on Thursday 14th May to see 'Matilda, the Musical'. This trip is being partly funded by FOWPs as part of an enrichment programme ensuring that all children have the opportunity to participate in a range of rich experiences.

The show has a start time of 2.30pm and we will be leaving school at lunchtime and returning at approximately 6pm. Exact timings will be confirmed nearer the time along with further information about arrangements for the day.

The subsidised cost will be £12, payable by Tuesday 5th May.

Although contributions are voluntary, we are very fortunate to be able to offer this at such a reduced cost, due to FOWPs partial funding of this event.
