Dear Parents,

This week we have continued to talk about our school value of 'Respect' – however we have turned our focus onto respecting our environment. This includes looking after our resources, tidying up our classrooms (and bedrooms at home) as well as recycling and not littering. I would like to remind all parents that our school is a smart phone free school. Where children have permission to bring in a phone (in Year 5 & 6) these must be handed in to the teacher who sends a box to the school office to be collected at the end of the day. In addition, no child is permitted to wear a smart watch, this is made clear in our uniform policy. Any watch with games, camera, internet or mobile connectivity is not permitted. Please do not send your child in wearing one, as they will be confiscated. As a reminder, as we phase out smartphones at the end of Year 6 this year, the current Year 5 will not be allowed them in school at the start of September 2026. They will be permitted to bring 'brick phones'.

Please find attached parent leaflets about Ordinarily Available Provision and SEN support. These have been developed by Hampshire County. The purpose of these is to provide information about Hampshire support for children with special educational needs and more information about what support is available.
